- Changed R402 footnote 5 to: Ducts & AHU installed “substantially leak free” per Section R403.2.2. Test required by either individuals as defined in Section 553.993(5) or (7), Florida Statutes, or individuals licensed as set forth in Section 489.105(3)(f), (g), or (i), Florida Statutes. The total leakage test is not required if ducts and air handlers are located entirely with the thermal envelope.
- Changed Total UA footnote 1 to: Ducts & AHU installed “substantially leak free” per Section R403.2.2. Test required by either individuals as defined in Section 553.993(5) or (7), Florida Statutes, or individuals licensed as set forth in Section 489.105(3)(f), (g), or (i), Florida Statutes. The total leakage test is not required if ducts and air handlers are located entirely with the thermal envelope.
